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**Construction Oversight Committee and East Rec Deck**

At the February board meeting, Iris Harrell, chair of the CoC will be presenting architectural design options for the east rec deck. Andie Altman will provide the results of the poll regarding what residents would like to see done with the deck.

**East Rec Entrance Sign**

The new entrance sign has been installed and looks great! I propose the Board consider replacing the dry-rotted Berger sign and the two west rec entrance signs with the same style sign. This will greatly improve the appearance of the entrances to these facilities.

**East Tennis Court Surface Issue**

The courts are open for play. The surface repairs will be addressed when it stops raining and warms up. (spring)

**Multi-Use Sports Court**

The sports court permit from the City has been issued along with the encroachment permit. The weather is not co-operating for Siri Construction to give OVA a construction start date.
