

OVA BULLETIN BOARDS POLICY

The OVA Office has many requests each month from residents and clubs wanting to post upcoming events on the four OVA Bulletin Boards. These bulletin boards are located outside of the OVA Office, Berger Center, West Recreation Center and the East Recreation Center. Since we have so many requests for posting information, it has become necessary to set a policy regarding OVA Bulletin Boards.

1. The OVA Office/Board of Directors has precedence over all other groups for bulletin board announcements.
2. Space permitting, only OVA Clubs with bylaws and Affiliated Organizations may post notices of events occurring within one month.
3. Event posters should be a maximum of 5 ½" X 8 ½" and must be approved by the OVA Office. OVA personnel will post and remove all notices.

Please note the attached policy.

Since our bulletin boards have not been overwhelmed by requests by groups, I am making some exceptions as long as bulletin boards are not full. President Bob Rodgers concurs.

As an exception, notices may be up to 8-1/2 by 11 inches in size; notices may be for multiple events up to a year. Such non-complying notices are subject to removal as described below.

In the event the bulletin boards become full and there are new notices to be posted, we will revert to the formal policy as long as bulletin boards remain full. Groups whose notices are removed have the right to resubmit new notices for re-posting when space permits. (We will not retain removed notices.)
