FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ABOUT RESIDENTIAL LISTINGS

Q: If I live in Oakmont am I listed automatically in the Oakmont telephone directory?

A: **No, to be listed in the directory you must fill out a data sheet and turn it in before the deadline.**

Q: If I move within Oakmont do I have to fill out a new fact sheet?

A: Yes, the information does *not* follow you.

Q: Do I have to complete a new sheet every year?

A: No, complete a new sheet only if you want to change something.

Q: Where do I get the data sheet?

A: At the OVA office.

Q: Do I have choices on how to be listed?

A: Yes, see the data sheet for details and listing options.

Q: Is it safe to be listed in the directory?

A: We do limit distribution to residents and businesses within Oakmont, but we cannot guarantee how it will be used. Many residents feel comfortable being listed in the Directory as an aid to fellow Oakmonters.

Q: I have a spouse, domestic partner, or housemate who has passed away. I still would like him/her to be listed with me in the phone book, is that okay?

A: Yes. In order for that person's name to remain listed in the phone book we must have an updated data sheet.
