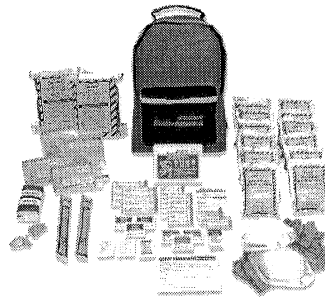
1. **Who Are You (Take with you)**
  - a. Name

  - h. List of any pets that live with you
2. **Emergency Contact**
  - a. Name(s)
  - b. Address
  - c. Phone Number(s)

  - e. Relationship(s)
3. **Medications & Supplements (Take with You) assemble a 2 weeks supply in a daily container)**
  - a. List
  - b. Dosage
  - c. Pharmacy you regularly use (should have your list in their system)
4. **Primary Care Doctor**
  - a. Name
  - b. Insurance (Kaiser, United Healthcare, Blue Cross etc.)
  - c. Contact Number
  - d. Health Insurance card
  - e. Dental Insurance – group # and Employee ID #
  - f. Medicare/Medicaid card
5. **Credit cards (Take with you)**
  - a. Name of card (bank or issuer)
  - b. Account number

6. **Debit Card (Take with you)**

7. **Checking Account (Take checks with you)**

8. **Insurance Documents (Take with you)**
  - a. Auto policy

9. **Personal Items (Take with you)**
  - a. Hearing aids
  - b. Wallet with cash
  - c. Eye glasses – regular and sun
  - d. Tooth brush, toothpaste, etc.
  - e. Hair brush, comb, Cosmetics, etc.
  - f. Sleep wear
  - g. 3 changes of clothes
  - h. 3 – 7 changes of underwear
  - i. 3 pair of shoes
  - j. Socks/stockings
  - k. Sweater and Jacket/overcoat, blanket(s)
  - l. Rain gear (weather determines)
  - m. Cell Phone, Tablet, laptop, iPad and charging cords, computer back up devices
  - n. Pet(s) with food and any medication
  - o. Camera
  - p. Flashlight & Batteries
  - q. Have with you or in a safe deposit box or in the cloud photos of your home and contents
  - r. Significant jewelry items e.g. wedding ring
  - s. Significant photos
  - t. Art items of special value

# IN CASE OF EVACUATION

- GET DRESSED TO DEPART – CLOSED TOED SHOES + JACKET
- TAKE YOUR PURSE/WALLET & KEYS TO HOUSE AND CAR
- TURN OFF GAS AT METER
- PACK PER CHECKLIST
- ASK FOR ASSISTANCE IF NEEDED FOR GARAGE DOOR OR ANYTHING ELSE
- HAVE YOUR SMART PHONE AND CHARGER/CORD AT HAND (CAR CONNECTION + WALL OUTLET CONNECTION)
- BRING FLASHLIGHT & BATTERIES– SMART PHONE HAS BUILT IN A FLASHLIGHT
- IF YOU HAVE A RADIO BRING IT. THERE IS ONE IN YOUR CAR
- GET PET(S) IN CARRIER(S) WITH FOOD/WATER
- PUT EVERYTHING IN CAR(S)
- HAVE A PREDETERMINED LOCATION TO EVACUATE TO
- MEET ON SIDEWALK BY BERN'S HOUSE (7275 OAKMONT DRIVE)
- MAKE SURE YOUR IMMEDIATE NEIGHBORS ARE WITH YOU
- LET BERN KNOW IF SOMEONE IS MISSING
- DON'T PANIC! WE'RE IN THIS TOGETHER!

## Consider purchasing an Emergency Backpack Kit – 3 –day supply

- (1) 2-person backpack
- Includes 33-piece first aid kit and 3 days of emergency food and water for 2 people
- Contains two 2400 calories food bars and six 8.45 oz. water boxes, each with a 5-year shelf life
- Includes basic survival essentials in accordance with American red cross recommendations
- 2 emergency safety light sticks
- 2 dust masks
- 2 pair of nitrile gloves
- 1 emergency whistle
- Emergency ponchos
- 1 pocket tissues
- 1-two person backpack
