

## SWIMMING POOL RULES

ALL POOLS AND POOL AREAS ARE FOR THE EXCLUSIVE USE AND ENJOYMENT OF OAKMONT RESIDENTS AND THEIR GUESTS  
(CHILDREN EXCLUDED EXCEPT FOR SPECIFIC DAILY HOURS AT CENTRAL POOL)

1. GUESTS ARE LIMITED TO FOUR (4) PER HOUSEHOLD AND MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN OAKMONT RESIDENT OR *INCLUDE AN ADULT (18 OR OLDER) WITH A GUEST CARD OBTAINED AT THE OVA OFFICE DURING REGULAR BUSINESS HOURS. EXCEPTIONS TO THE LIMIT OF 4 MAY BE APPROVED BY THE OVA MANAGER ON A CASE-BY-CASE BASIS.*
2. ALL PERSONS ARE REQUIRED TO SHOWER BEFORE ENTERING POOL OR SPA. PERSONS USING OILS OR LOTIONS MUST SHOWER EACH TIME BEFORE RE-ENTERING THE POOL OR SPA.
3. FOR SAFETY REASONS, NO DIVING INTO THE POOLS OR RUNNING IN POOL AREAS IS ALLOWED.
4. PERSONS WEARING BANDAGES OR WITH OPEN WOUNDS ARE NOT PERMITTED IN POOLS OR SPAS.
5. SUBJECT TO GUEST RULES, PERSONS 18 YEARS OF AGE & OLDER MAY USE ANY POOL OR SPA.
6. NO FOOD, BEVERAGE, GLASS, METAL OR OTHER TYPE OF CONTAINER (PLASTIC WATER BOTTLE EXCEPTED) IS PERMITTED IN POOL AREAS.
7. PETS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN POOL AREAS - EXCEPTION: LEASHED ASSISTANCE DOGS.
8. LARGE FLOTATION DEVICES SUCH AS INNER TUBES, AIR MATTRESSES AND LARGE TOYS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN POOLS, SPAS OR POOL AREAS.
9. PROPER SWIMMING ATTIRE IS TO BE WORN WHILE SWIMMING.
10. SPECIAL RULES FOR CENTRAL POOL AND POOL AREA
  - a. ***CHILDREN (17 years of age or younger) are allowed access to the Central Pool when accompanied by an Oakmont resident or an adult 18 years or older with a valid guest card every day of the year between the hours of 11:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. No change is made to the special hours specified in the current policy for children's access between Saturday of Memorial Day Weekend through Labor Day, Monday (with hours of Noon to 4:00 p.m.).***
  - b. INFANTS NOT TOILET TRAINED ARE NOT PERMITTED IN THE POOL OR SPA.
  - c. AN ADULT MUST ACCOMPANY CHILDREN 12 YEARS OLD OR YOUNGER USING REST ROOM FACILITIES.
11. **DISCOURTESY OR FAILURE TO OBSERVE POOL RULES MAY RESULT IN SUSPENSION OF PRIVILEGES OF THE RESIDENT.**
