

Introduction

Don't forget to pack for your entire family, including your fur babies! Consider preparing 2 emergency kits: one for home and one to have with you.

Supplies to Pack

The only difference between dogs and cat's supplies is food and toys.

Food & water - 3-day supply per pet (minimum, up to 2 weeks best)

- Can opener & plastic lid
- Non-spill collapsible food and water bowls
- Single water pouches

Bedding

12-Hour green light stick (to see pets in the dark) Emergency mylar blanket for warmth Sanitation needs - kitty litter and box; plastic bags for waste disposal; paper towels. Extra leash and collar with ID tag, harness (reflective) Metal stake with tie-down leash Nylon cord – 50' Medications Grooming items Pet carriers, with emergency decal, name, address, and phone# affixed Pet first-aid kit/manual/survival guide Favorite toys, treats, beds (helps reduce stress)

Documents to Pack

Current photos of you and your pet together (to help document ownership)

Emergency contacts, including Vet

ID chip number and name of company

List of animal shelters & pet-friendly hotels

Medical and vaccination records, including rabies certificate

Pet identification info / id tags

Proof of pet insurance and contact info

Proof of ownership

Bucket w/ tight-fitting lid for food

Emergency storage supplies container

Things You Can Do Ahead

Take a pet first-aid/CPR class! Practice crate training Place "Pets Inside" stickers on doors and windows

- * indicate the number and types of pets
- * include phone number on sticker
- * write "Evacuated with Pets" across stickers should you evacuate

<u>Plan</u>

Where to evacuate

Develop a buddy system

- * share evacuation plans in case you're not home when there's an evacuation, your neighbors will evacuate your pets.
- * location of pet's emergency kit
- * designate specific 2 meeting locations (both close and far away)

Talk to vet about emergency planning
