



Evacuation Route – Know Your Ways Out of Oakmont

The main routes out of Oakmont are from Pythian Rd. and Oakmont Dr. to Highway 12. Depending on the circumstances, you may have the option of turning left or right onto Highway 12.

The access to Channel Drive as an evacuation route will be opened **ONLY** with approval by the SRFD or SRPD and **ONLY** when evacuation from Oakmont is critical and evacuation in that direction is necessary and safe. You will know when Channel Dr is open because there may be SRPD/SRFD officers directing traffic in that direction, and the locked gate from Oakmont into Wild Oak will be opened **IF** Channel Drive is authorized to be used as an evacuation route. If you don't know where Channel Drive is, see the map below.

According to Paul Lowenthal, SRFD, Channel Drive is possible to be used as an Emergency Evacuation Route but it depends on the circumstances of what is happening. It may need to be used for getting emergency crews into Oakmont so in that case it would not be used as an evacuation route out. It could also be threatened by fire as it was during the Glass Fire of 2020.

Directions

- Oakmont Dr to White Oak Dr
(heading into Wild Oak)
- Enter Wild Oak through a coded gate, which will be open if authorized as an evacuation route
- Turn right onto Timber Springs Rd which connects to Channel Dr
- Continue on Channel Dr along Annadel Park
- It comes out on Montgomery Dr near Spring Lake Village
