

How Do You Evacuate if You Don't Drive?

This question is a common one in Oakmont, and there is only one simple answer: "HAVE A PLAN". Make arrangements ahead of time with close friends and neighbors to look out for each other. Each person needs to take personal responsibility for their own safety.

WHAT IF....?

- you don't drive and must evacuate Oakmont? What's YOUR Plan?
- your spouse/partner is away from the house, and an earthquake hits? What's YOUR plan?
- your spouse/partner is away from the house, and there's an **Evacuation Order** (which means evacuate right now). **What's YOUR plan?**

<u>Have a Plan and a Back-up Plan</u>. Work with friends and neighbors to develop plan A and Plan B. During an evacuation of any size there are many moving parts, and each person needs to take personal responsibility to develop a plan for their own safety. People working together really are the solutions.

"Call 911" should be a last resort at a time when first responder resources are already stretched to the limit. Delays could put people at risk.
